Steven Bond-Smith is Associate Director and Associate Professor at the University of Hawai'i Economic Research Organization (UHRO), University of Hawai'i at Mānoa. He is a co-editor of *Spatial Economic Analysis* and a Productivity Fellow at The Productivity Institute in the United Kingdom. His research advances theoretical, empirical and policy insights in spatial economics, productivity and regional development, with publications in the *Journal of Economic Geography*, *Journal of Regional Science*, *Cities*, *Urban Studies* and *Economic Development Quarterly*, among others.

Beyond scholarship, he contributes to policy development and economic debate. He serves on Hawai'i's State Planning Act Task Force, the Tourism and Gaming Working Group, the O'ahu Workforce Development Board, and the United Kingdom Department for Transport's Shadow Joint Analysis Development Panel, advising on economic development, infrastructure and growth.
